



Migrants in Bulgaria by Country [Data from 2017]

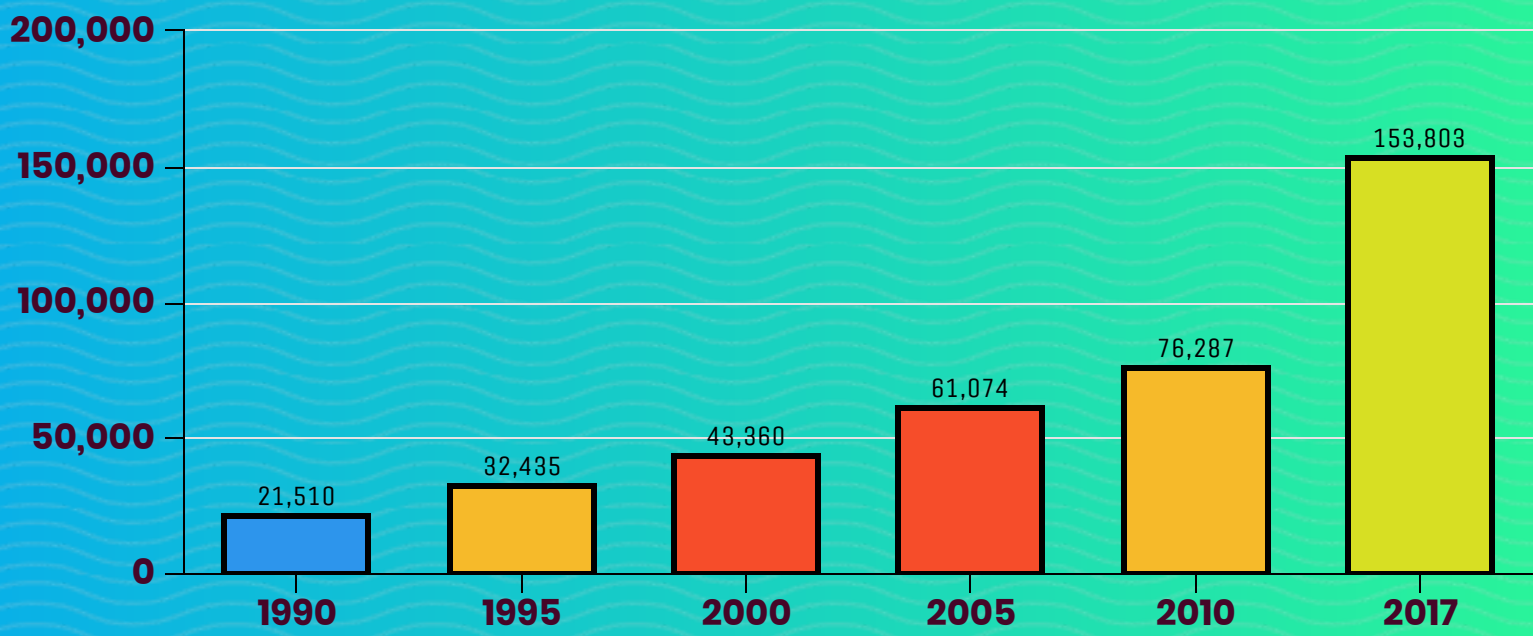
According to the United Nations, an international migrant is someone who has been living for one year or longer in a country other than the one in which he or she was born.
