

10 WAYS TO GET AROUND IN BULGARIA

1 BY LONG DISTANCE PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Buses are frequently used in Bulgaria for long-distance travel. Besides public buses, coaches are also operated by private companies. Some International destinations include Saloniki, Istanbul, Bucharest, Skopje and Belgrad

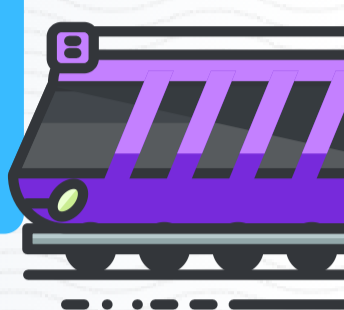
HELPFUL TIP: Tickets can be purchased at the offices of these companies, at stations and from the bus driver.



2 BY RAILWAYS

Bulgaria offers over 4000 km of rail track. The main rail hub is in the capital city Sofia, which has connections to Romania, Serbia and Turkey.

HELPFUL TIP: Expressen Vlak
Faster trains (routes: Sofia to Plovdiv, Sofia to Varna, Sofia to Burgas).
Reservations are required (approximately €0.25, or BGN 0.50 in local currency).



3 BY AIR TRANSPORT

Currently Bulgaria has 5 international airports: in the cities of Sofia, Varna, Plovdiv, Burgas y Gorna Oryahovitsa (this one without commercial flights)



HELPFUL TIP: Bulgaria Air is the flag carrier airline of Bulgaria.

4 BY WATERWAYS IN BULGARIA

Bulgaria has 3 different kind of ports, River ports on the Danube river, Sea Ports in Varna and Burgas and Yatch ports along the Black Sea coast



HELPFUL TIP: You can cross the Dunabe river, to Romania with your car in a ferryboat

5 BY ROAD WITH A CAR

Bulgaria had around 37,300 kilometers of roads. Before you can drive on motorways, you will need to purchase and display a highway toll sticker – a 'vignette' – on the vehicle's passenger-side (right-side) windscreen.

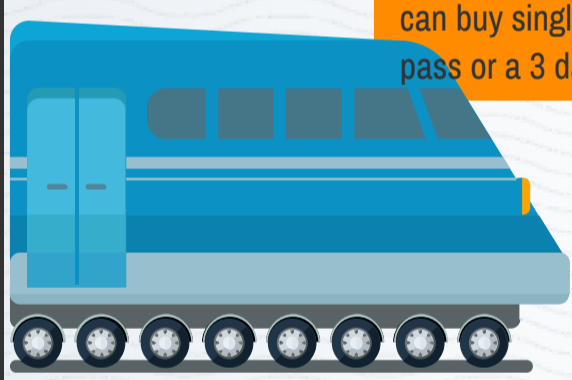
HELPFUL TIP: The maximum speed in the highway is 140 km/h and normal roads 100 km/h



6 BY METRO IN SOFIA

Is the rapid transit network servicing Sofia, was inaugurated in 1998, it has 2 lines and you can reach the Airport and the Bus/train Station

HELPFUL TIP: If you are visiting Sofia, you can buy single trip, a daily pass or a 3 days pass.



7 BY BICYCLE

Ciclyng in Bulgaria provide an unique experience you will find mountains, lakes, rivers and the Black Sea coast, you will never fell boring

HELPFUL TIP: You can always combine your cycling touring with a wide variety of cultural and historical sights



8 BY LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Depending on the city the fares of the local public transport can be different, ranging the price for a trip from 1.60 levs in Sofia to 1.00 lev in Varna



HELPFUL TIP: If Ask how the payment system works, in some towns you have to buy the ticket before to get into the bus

9 BY TAXI

Getting around the town in taxi in Bulgaria isn't as expensive as many other European countries, its a good option when moving in groups

HELPFUL TIP: Each taxi can settle his own fare, be careful, and before taking a tit check the price per km.



10 BY WALK

All around Bulgaria there are hundreds of kilometers of Eco trails, that will take around the most beautiful Bulgarian places and villages, making your experience unforgettable
