

# MUNICIPAL BUDGET 2019

## A yearly process for the municipalities

Bulgaria is divided into 265 municipalities. Are governed by a mayor who is elected by popular majority vote for a four-year term, and a municipal council which is elected using proportional representation for a four-year term.
